Fellow "Cousins" far and wide:

This has been a busy year for me as your new secretary, getting used to the job and what is expected of me. Our association members total approximately 508 now. I have tried to answer your letters as soon as possible. I did get behind in the fall with the membership cards but am caught up now. I have enjoyed hearing from many of you. Thank you for letting me know of changes in your addresses and in family members. I appreciate more and more all the work Miriam did these past ten years.

Our president Mark has been busy getting all the names in his computer, and has the records quite complete now. The address labels this time are a result of his work. He will be telling us more about what he has planned and how the information will be most useful to all in future mailings and at the meeting in August.

Get your calendars out and put a BIG CIRCLE around AUGUST 3 and 4, 1984. That is the date of this years meeting to be held in Providence, Rhode Island in honor of #8 John. Our headquarters will be at the Howard Johnson Motel in Warwick. Rates and details will be forthcoming in the next mailing the end of May. Hazard and Jeanne Knowles and Mark are working on the plans.

Those of you who were at the 1982 meeting here in Suffield probably will remember seeing the Dr. Alexander King House on Main St., Suffield. We did not go in it but pointed it out on the bus tour. It is owned by the Suffield Historical Society. Our speaker Hawley Rising, a member of that group spoke of it too. This winter tragedy struck. Late at night the house caught fire and was extensively damaged. Prompt action by our town firemen and of neighboring towns were able to save some of the furnishings and put the fire out before it was totally destroyed. The Historical Society has already made plans to rebuild and repair, have already started a fund campaign to raise the necessary money. It will take much more than the insurance they received. Many people have volunteered to clean and repair what can be salvaged. It shows just how vulnerable our old wooden museums are that we have been in on our bus tours.

Another place that many of your who have visited Suffield will be interested in and those that were here in 1982. The large dairy barn and hay barn at the Jonathan Sheldon House was totally destroyed by fire late one night this winter too. The wind was in the right direction and the house and the surrounding buildings were saved.

The Town of Windsor, Conn. held their 350th Anniversary last September. They attempted to reach as many descendants of founding fathers as possible. They have Isaac Sheldon as a founding father and I was contacted. Letters were sent to as many as possible (on very short notice) with Isaac lineage in the eastern part of the country. Several attended the program they had. Unfortunately I was not able to be there. That day they formed a Descendants of Founding Fathers of Windsor. All of the Isaac line received a paper on it in the last mailing. I have since joined it and attended a meeting in March. I met a woman there that is an Isaac line but not a member of our association. She wants to join. Another meeting is planned for September and a two week trip to England for May 1985. A very active group.

I seem to be having a lot of news about this area. Of course that is because I am here. For future mailings I would be glad to mention news about happenings in and about some of the places we have seen in recent years.

Does anyone have any ideas on where to hold the 1985 meeting? It seems a long way off, but we really need to be thinking two and three years in advance of possible places to go. We would also need to have someone in the area help with the planning. If you have any thoughts along this line please let me know and I will pass the info along to the other officers.

We received a \$100.00 Gift in memory of Irene Ciecierski of Bristol, Conn. given by her husband. Those at the 1982 meeting may remember my father who had four generations present. I am sorry to report that he passed away on January 11, 1984 after living a full life of almost 91 years, and was active in community affairs almost to the end.

I am again enclosing a membership blank for anyone that has not paid their dues up to Aug. 1984. There are 45 paid only to 1982 and 75 paid only to 1983. The years do slip by so fast but let's try to all get caught up soon. If you aren't sure look at your label. The year you are paid to is on it. This will be the last mailing to the ones paid only to 1982.

BOOK LIST

Magazines, Essays, & Pamphlets about SHELDONS

THE SHELDON MAGAZINES - originally published in the mid 1850's by S#5124, the Rev. Henry O. Sheldon, have been updated by another hundred years and more. Originally only four magazines were published. Material for the fifth had been gathered but not published. The sixth volume was done by the Sheldon Family Association, the committee being headed by the late Leland L. Sheldon, S#6770x41. Over 13,000 names of SHELDONS and more of their connections who lived prior to 1850 are listed in these 'magazines' of about 280 pages. Indexes cover all "Heads of Families." This "MAGAZINE" is, in fact, a listing of names by family and number, with birth and death years when known, and spouses and their death date, and last known residence. We can again supply the six Magazines, though assorted sizes and forms. Volume numbers I & V are slightly smaller than the others in outside dimensions, though the thickness remains the same. These are stapled but can be made to fit a 3-ring binder if desired. As to the other volumes, we will ship the best that we have, be it stapled or punched (held together with fasteners.) The covers are spring-binders, hard cover, made by the ELRE Company. The front cover has printed in gold, THE SHELDONS OF AMERICA. The spine has THE SHELDON MAGAZINE 1855 - 1857 REVISED 1960. There is no updating since that date. When these are gone, they will be 'out of print.'

"ISAAC SHELDON OF WINDSOR, CONN." - a 14 page copy of an article published in the April 1963 issue of the NEW ENGLAND HISTORICAL & GENEALOGICAL REGISTER. The author is our own S#4760x52 Charlotte A. Hunt of Worcester, Mass. A well documented article, it includes a map of Windsor and a diagram of the lots owned by S#5 Isaac SHELDON and his neighbors, and a photostat reproduction of the page (40) of the original Land Record Book in the Connecticut State Library in Hartford which has been the basis for the argument as to whether there was an Isaac #1 or not.

"HISTORICAL SKETCH OF THE SHELDON FAMILY" by Henry Waters SHELDON, S#7879x5, (1863-1942) of Yonkers, N.Y., prepared and read by him at the annual reunion of the SHELDON family at Rupert, VT, August 8, 1912. In 1913 Roy Farrar SHELDON of Schenectady, N.Y., published it in book form. Of interest to all SHELDONS, we present it in manuscript form, copied from the book.

"QUAKERISM" - a fairly new production by the Genealogical Committee, includes "A CAPTIVE QUAKER WHO HELPED FREE THE COLONIES' CAPTIVES IN BRITISH PRISON CAMP" and "JONATHAN SHELDON, 'THE FIGHTING QUAKER.'" This is a story that was published in the New York Knickerbocker Press, Sept. 22, 1929, written by Major Alex Well, concerning S#8050 Capt. Jonathan SHELDON of Rhode Island, a descendant of the Providence/Pawtuxet John (S#81) Charts of his ancestors and descendants are also included as an aid to your making a possible connection in this line.

"STORIES OF EARLY DAYS OF THE SETTLEMENT OF AURORA, OHIO" - the story of 'going west' as it was in 1800, when Capt. Ebenezer SHELDON (S#627 of the Isaac #5 line) of Suffield, CT, left New England and moved westerly, settling in Aurora. These stories have been passed down from generation to generation, and it is through the kindness of Gertrude McDonald, a descendant living in Aurora, that we present this fascinating collection in manuscript form.

THE STORY OF REMEMBRANCE SHELDON (S#113) - who was captured in the 1704 raid on Deerfield, Massachusetts by the French and Indians when he was eleven years old. Fourteen years later he related this story on the evening before his wedding day. It was transcribed by Martha J. Hyde in 1900. A booklet.

JOHN SHELDON AND THE OLD INDIAN HOUSE HOMESTEAD by Jennie Arms SHELDON (S#2981.) This perhaps is the best story of the Deerfield Massacre - a paper read at the annual meeting of the Pocumtuck Valley Memorial Association, August 12, 1911. In booklet form of 21 pages.

An error has finally been discovered in the list of children of #46 Jonathan in the *Historical Sketch of the Sheldon Family* by Harry Waters Sheldon. Upon being advised of this, your chairman has referred back to the original printing of the little book which was printed just following the presentation in 1912, and discovered that the printer left out a line, apparently in his copywork. This may account for the reason that #205 Phineas was left out of some of the artistic charts we have seen. The paragraph on page 9 of the older mimeographed copies, and page 8 of the newer printed copies should read:

"The family of Captain Jonathan consisted of ten children, six sons and four daughters: Mehitable, born 1709, married Samuel Warner; Jonathan, born 1711, married Sarah Kent; Rebecca, born 1714, married John Norton; Daniel b. 1715, married Mary Harmon; Phineas, b. 1717 married Deborah Hathaway, and second, Mrs. Ruth H. Smith, and third, a Mrs. Pomeroy."

The article did not include the third born, an infant who died without name. Our thanks to Mrs. A.M. Sheldon who reported this at Bennington last year.

REPORT of the SECOND VICE-PRESIDENT

Chairman, Genealogical Committee

August 1984

The first project of the year involved putting our membership's mailing addresses in order. Having had the records of the late Leland L. Sheldon during my term of office, I was called upon to dig out some of these records to find when members joined, when last they attended an annual meeting, and their Sheldon identification number (S#) and the progenitor of each. The S# and progenitor I had on my address index, but there were several I didn't have, even members I didn't have. Therefore I started writing letters, in spurts, and basically alphabetically. Now, it was not my intention to insult anyone or find them at fault. Actually, I was embarrassed for not realizing I had some of these numbers right under my nose. Luck was with me in a few cases, and I came across some while tracking other business of the day. However, there are still a few members who have ignored my letter, or perhaps fire or air crashes have intervened. If you find that you are not listed with some letter, a G, I, J, W or X, then know that you need to get your ancestry made known to us. It's also important to keep us informed of your moves, perhaps a retirement home, for where the name is frequently the same, we want to be sure which John, Charles, Benjamin, Richard and Robert made the move. Please give your old address as well as your new, and your S# always helps, too, to the Secretary, President, or chairperson of the Genealogical Committee.

During the winter, we started our second project, and by the first of March I was able to mail over fifty letters to various libraries across the country who had either purchased, or been given by members, volumes 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the "Sheldon Magazine" to see if they had volumes 1 and 6. These last two were published in 1973 & 1969, respectively, for Leland had hoped to have the answers of the relationship of our progenitors to be put at the beginning of #1. But by then, he was failing in health and could not carry on as valiantly as before. His cellar was flooded from a particularly bad winter storm off the Great Lakes, and too many issues were lost to follow up on his library project. We have finished this commitment by sending to those who responded, the missing copies with an insert - "In Loving Memory of Leland Locke Sheldon - (1883-1982.)"

We've sent an uncountable number of photo-copies of our lineage file cards to members requesting such. These cards tell the story in better detail than does the "Sheldon Magazine." One is made for each generation that is submitted by new members. Others get made up as we hear from those of you who spend hours in genealogical libraries and come across information which though it isn't your particular line, offer it to us, for it may be of vital use in helping our GKW's. I particularly would like to thank Rose Marie Newton for the results of her many hours at the Fort Wayne Library.

This card business is how I got started on this committee. I had thought that by now we would have caught up with the redoing of the cards, typing them all so that they might be clearly read if we chose to have them micro-filmed. Time marches on, and now the outlook is to the computer. For this reason, I have suggested that we have a new chairman and the files broken up by progenitor. In this manner, this job can be accomplished. When this is all done, we can expect to have it computerized. More on this from our President.

Best wishes to Shirley Rider as she takes over the helm of the Genealogical Committee. I know she will serve you well.

Thank you all for your kindness and thoughtfulness, your research, your letters of praise and approval, your questions and corrections. These have been most enjoyable and rewarding years for me.

Since I will still be running the bookstore, let me tell you of our latest acquisitions. I found copies of a letter dated in 1876 written to the Plattsburg Sentinel and the Essex County Republican - both New York newspapers - by Oscar F. Sheldon, S#6194. Having received gracious permission from his descendant, Mrs. William Bunyan of Fowler, Kansas, to issue this to our membership, we have titled it from one of the first sentences, "Historic Memories of the Past." It is triple-spaced for easy reading, running six pages. A map on the cover points out the various towns mentioned therein - around Lake Champlain. Historical buffs and descendants of those whose ancestors lived there two hundred years ago, and less, will find it most interesting and enjoyable. We're selling this at just one dollar plus fifty cents for postage and handling. If it is ordered with other literature, the 75¢ postage fee will cover all. Just write "Memories" on our current order blank of the booklist.

On display at our Annual Meeting, we had copies of S#5 Isaac's and #46 Jonathan's Wills, with typed transcriptions done by Shirley Rider. These also include their inventories, a lineage chart showing Isaac and his children, and photos. We took several orders at that time. These will sell at \$5.00 for the complete set, or \$2.50 for just Isaac's Will. Postage in either case will be \$1.00. These will not fit in a bundle with any of the other literature as the reproductions are twice the size of this sheet, and we do not wish to fold them.
